



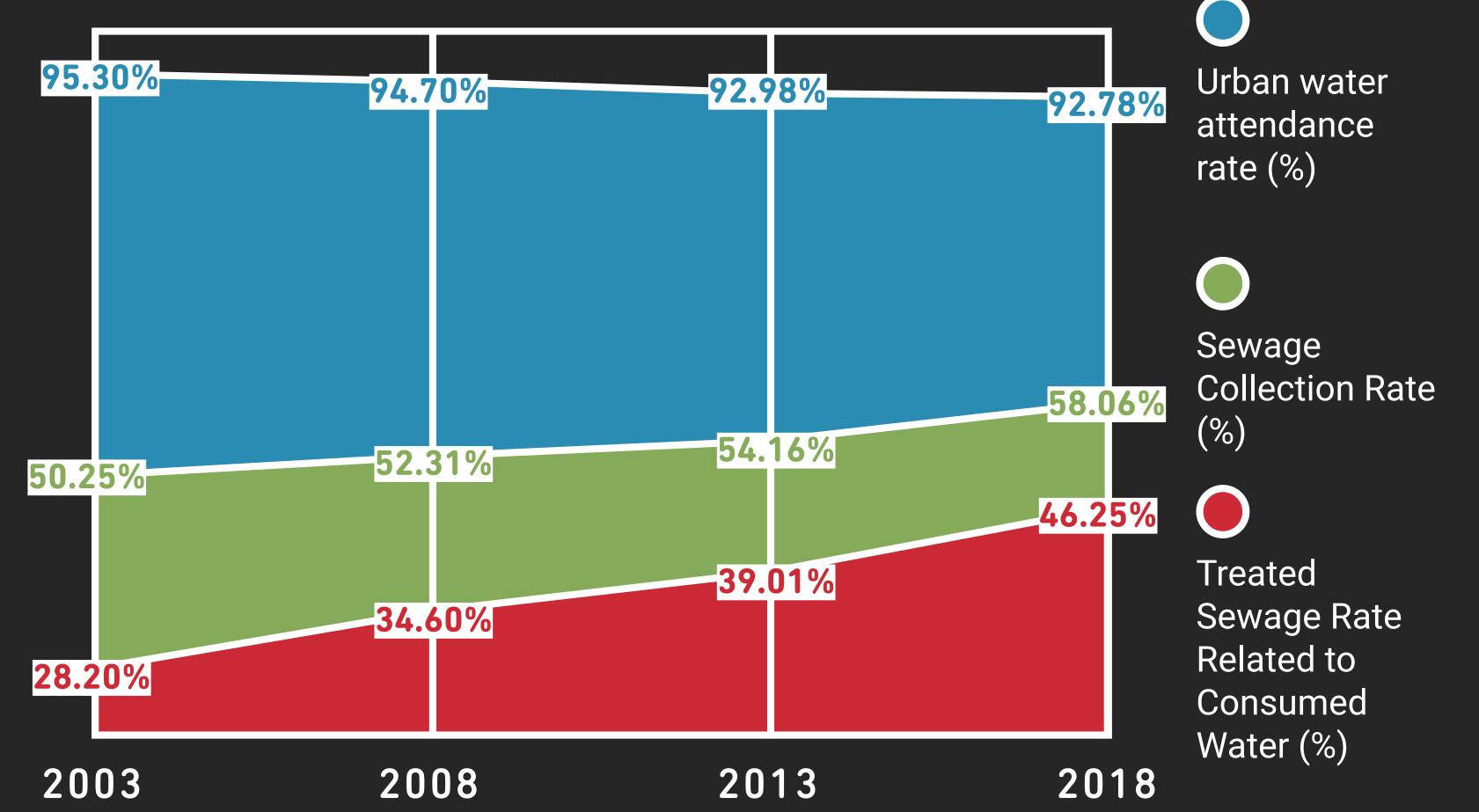

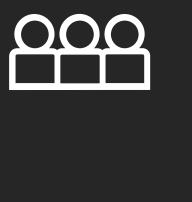

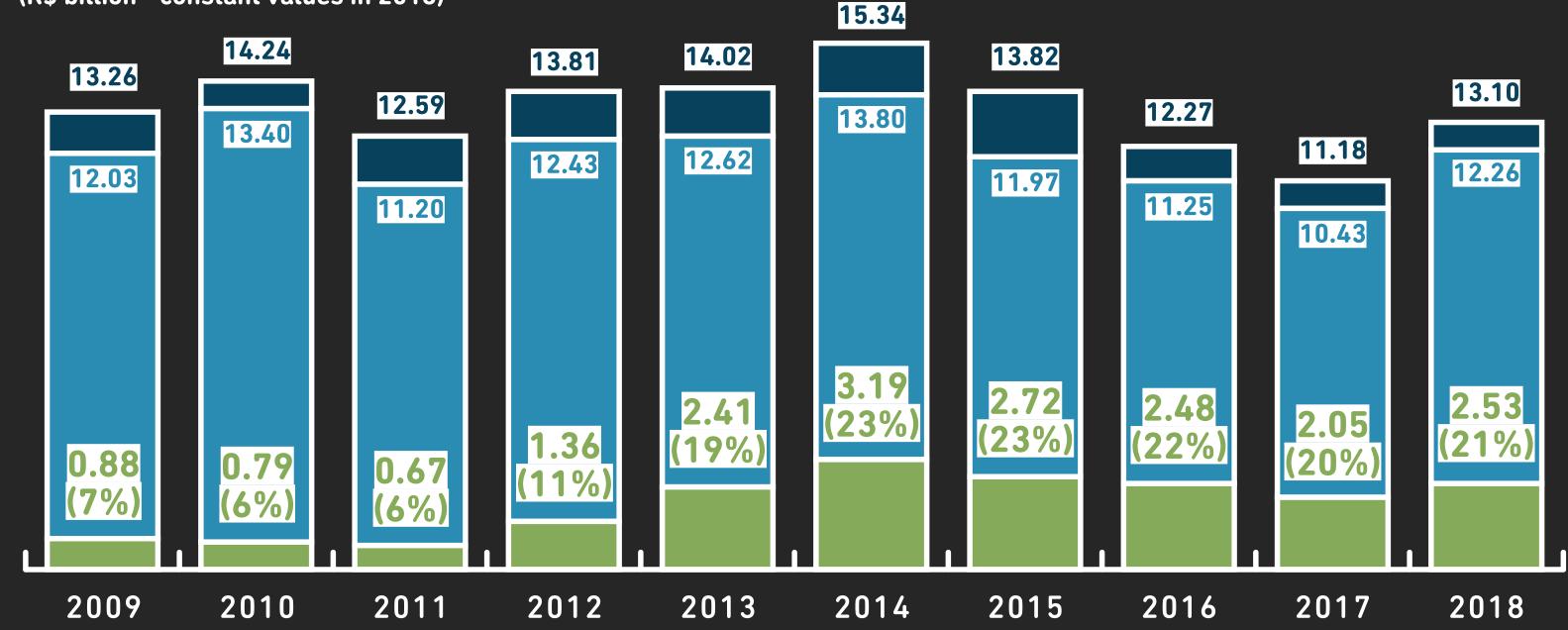

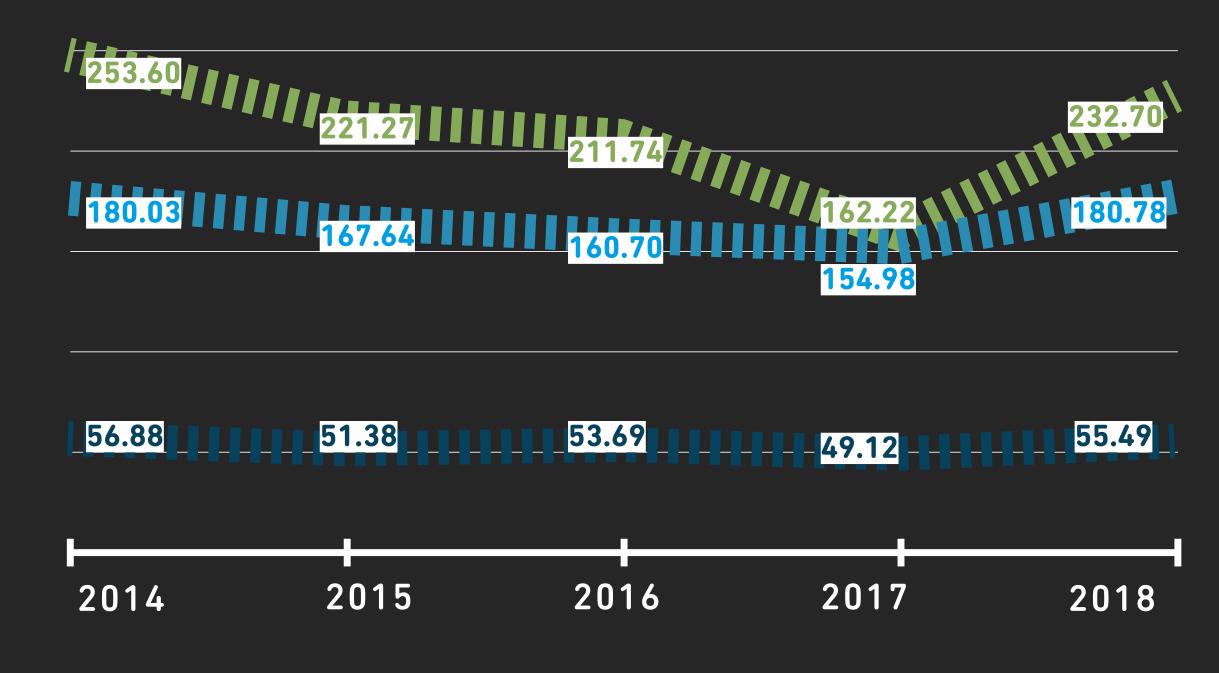

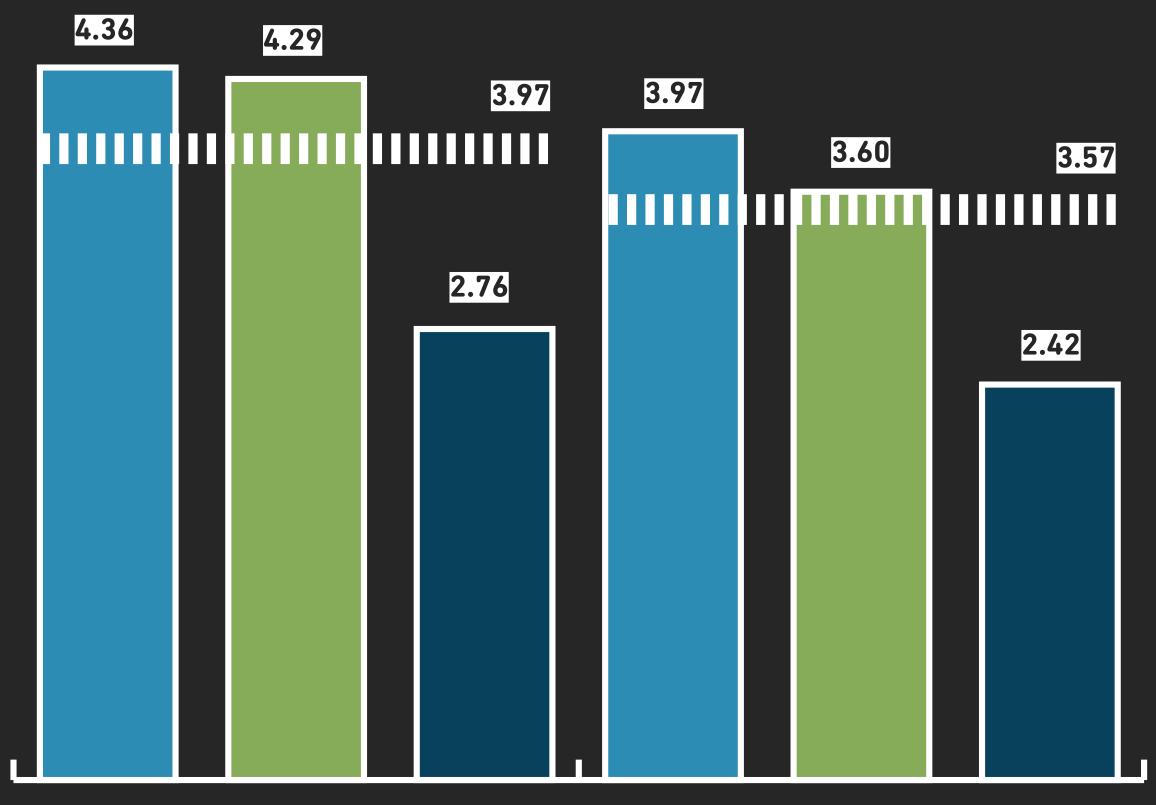

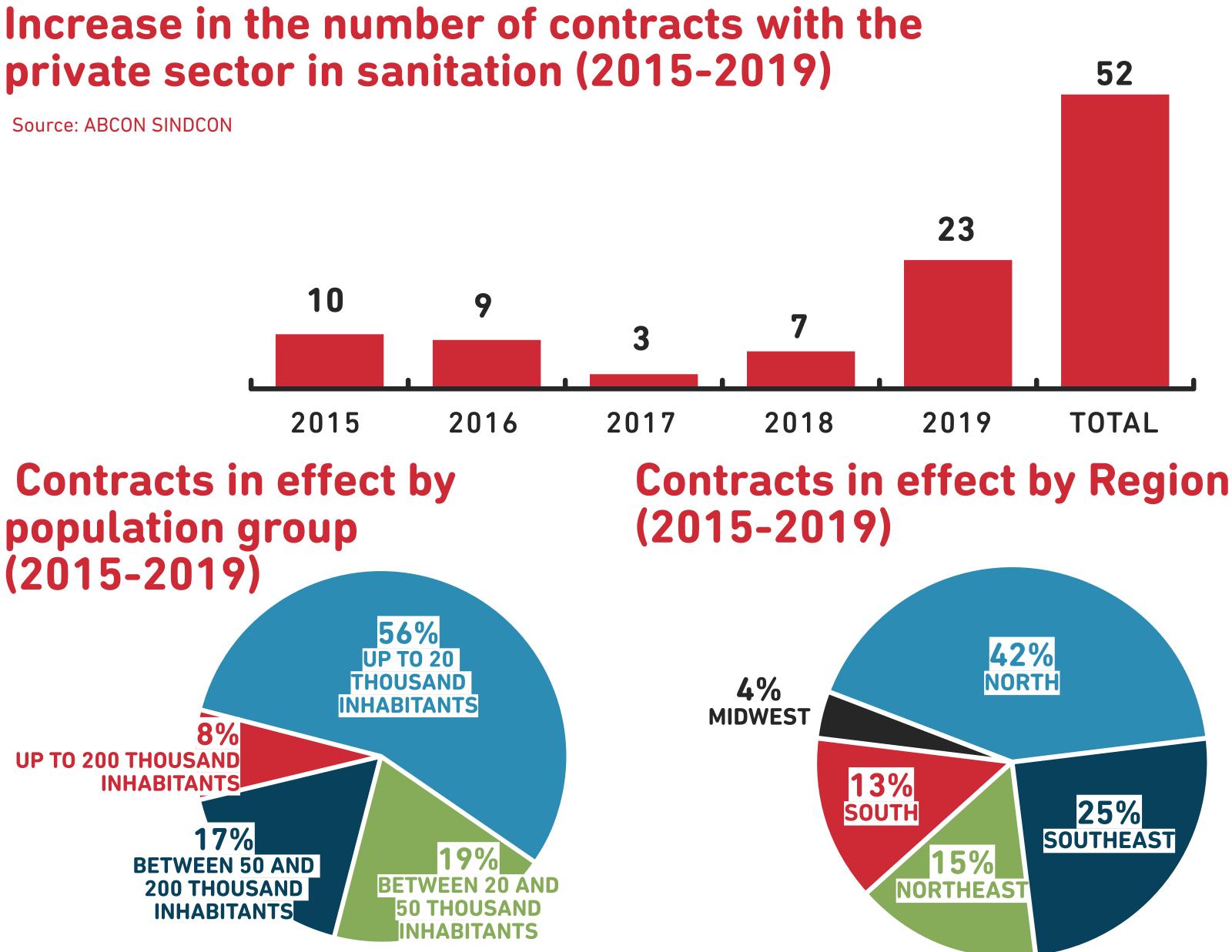

MARKET'S MOVEMENT

In 2019, there was a significant increase in the number of contracts signed with the private sector. This movement occurred due to the expectation created by the approval of the new legal framework for sanitation, which will significantly increase regulatory quality.

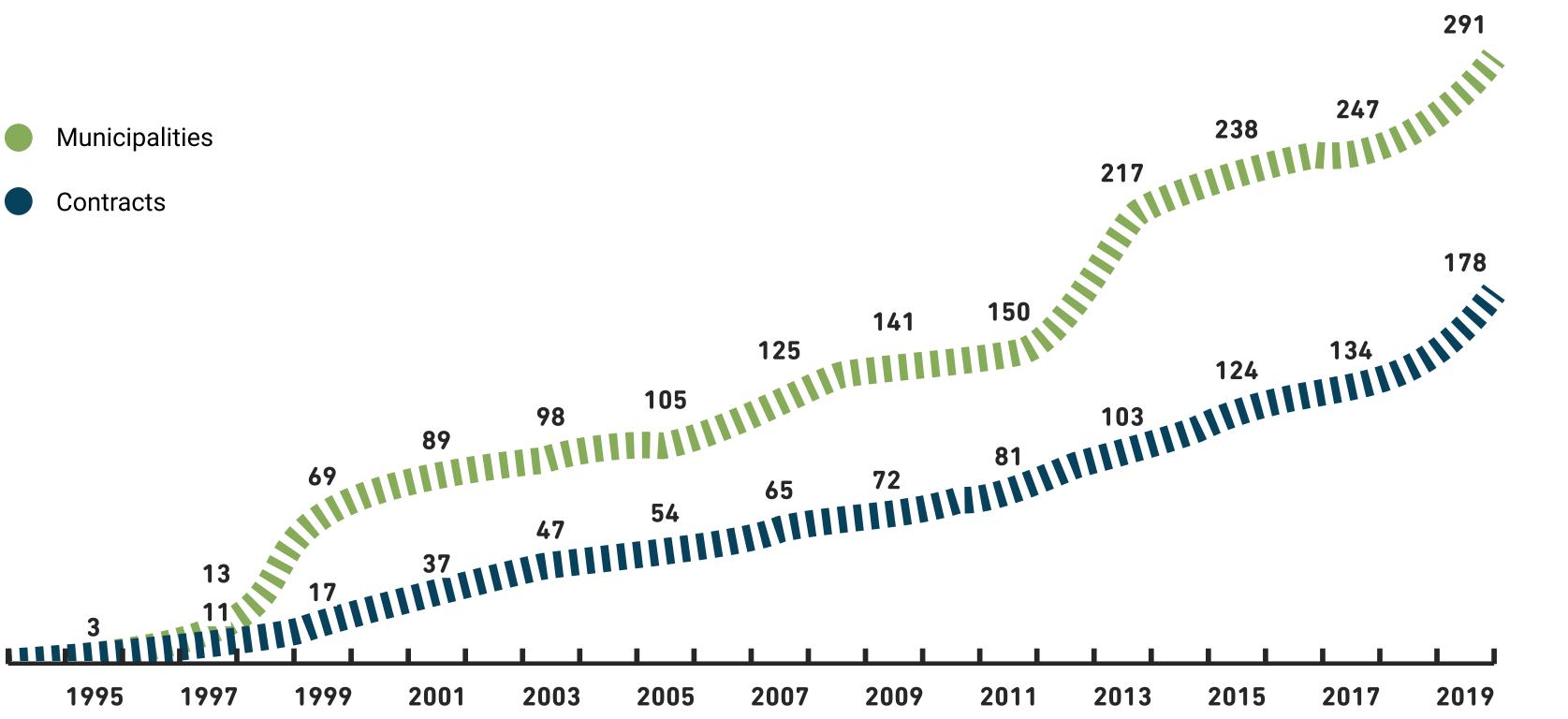

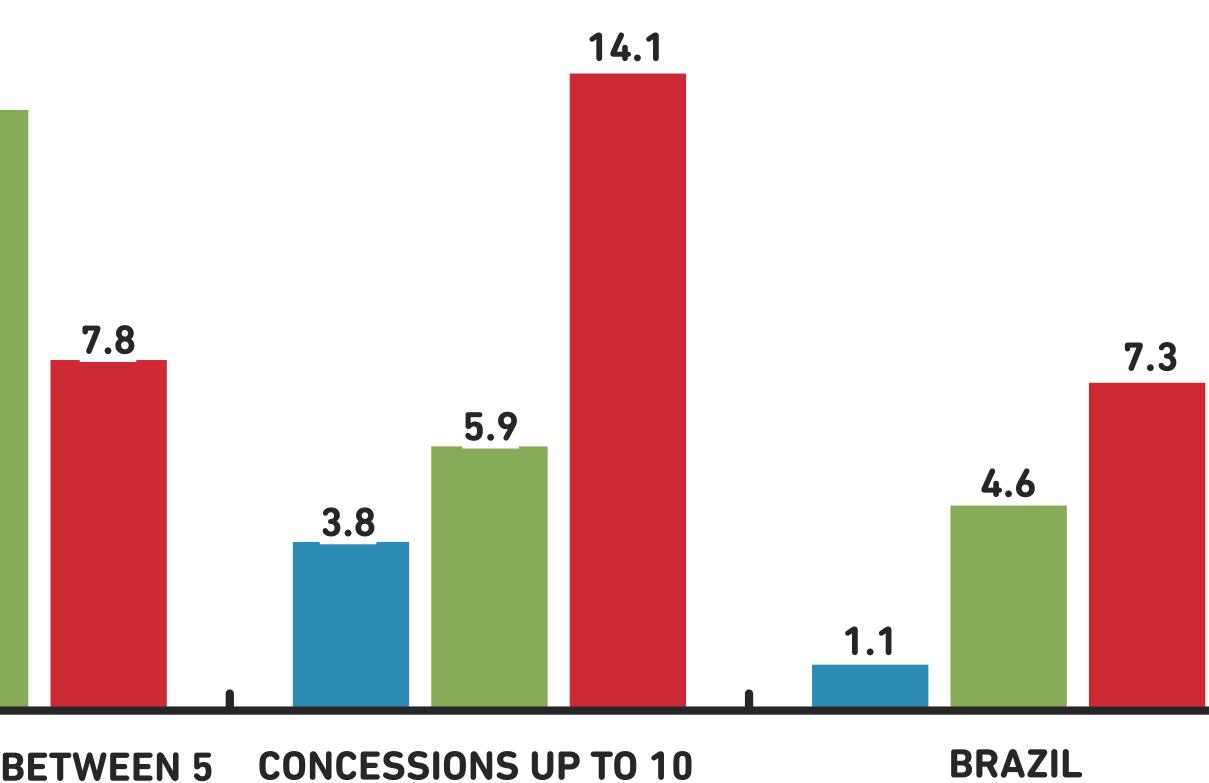

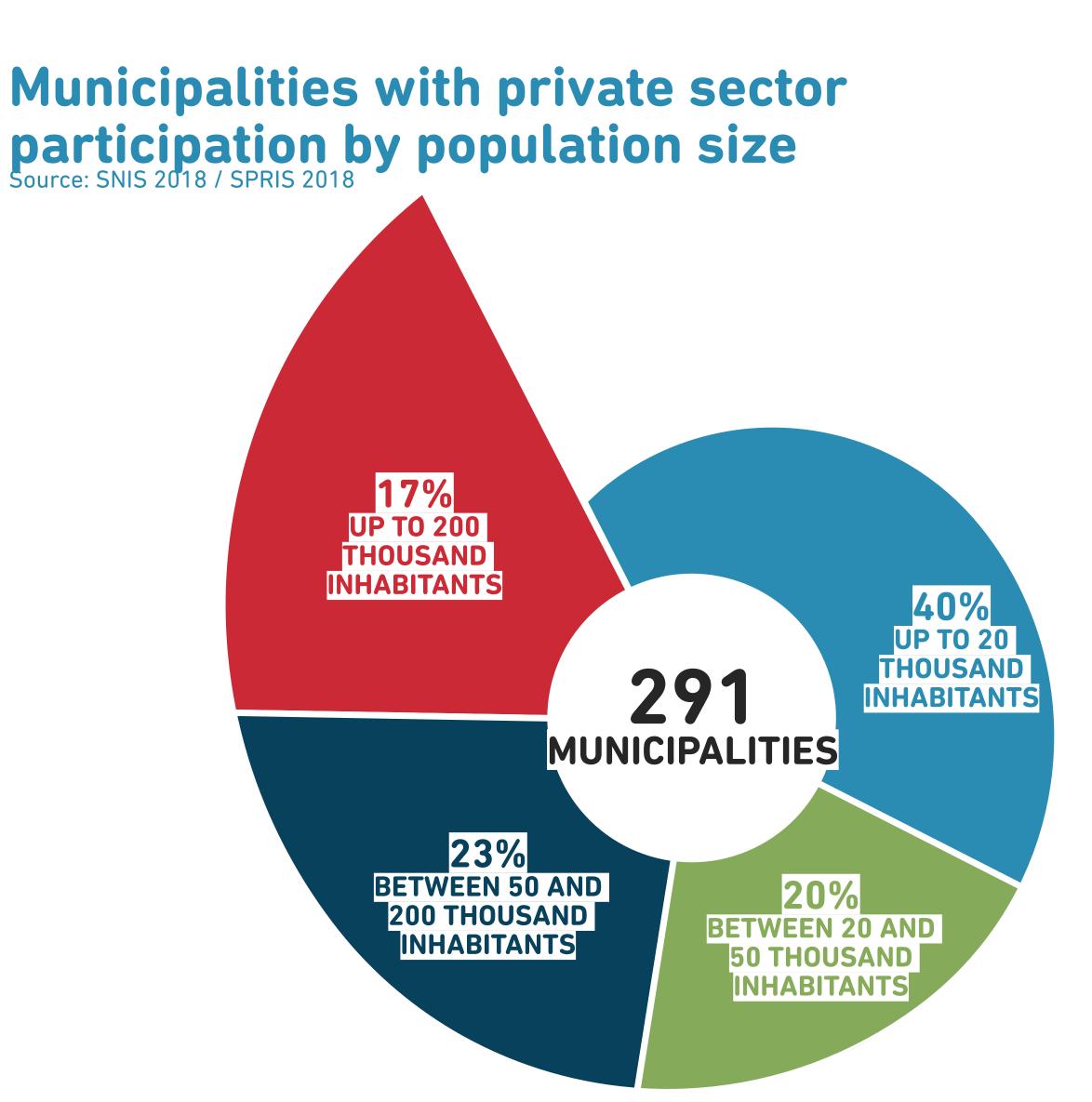

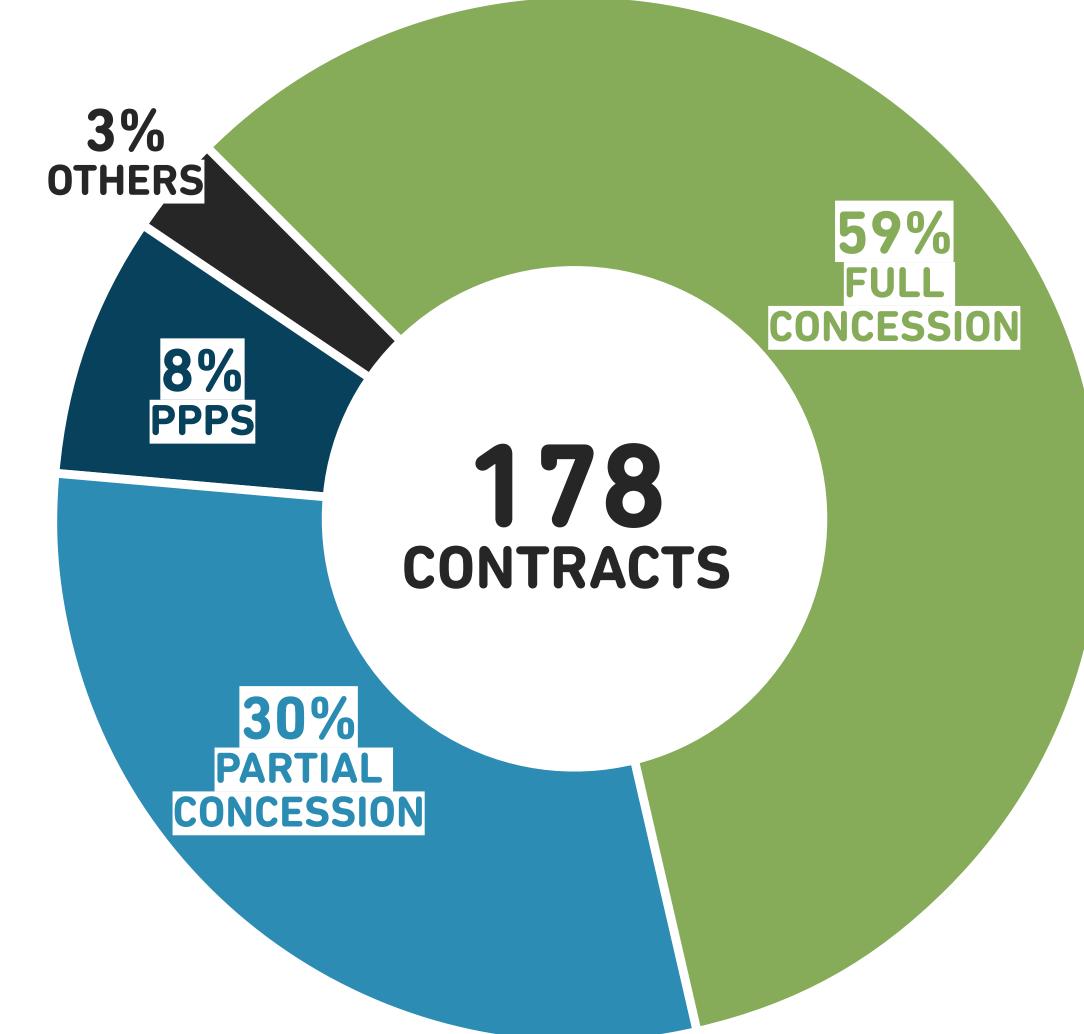






PRIVATE SECTOR PROFILE BY CONTRACT TYPE:

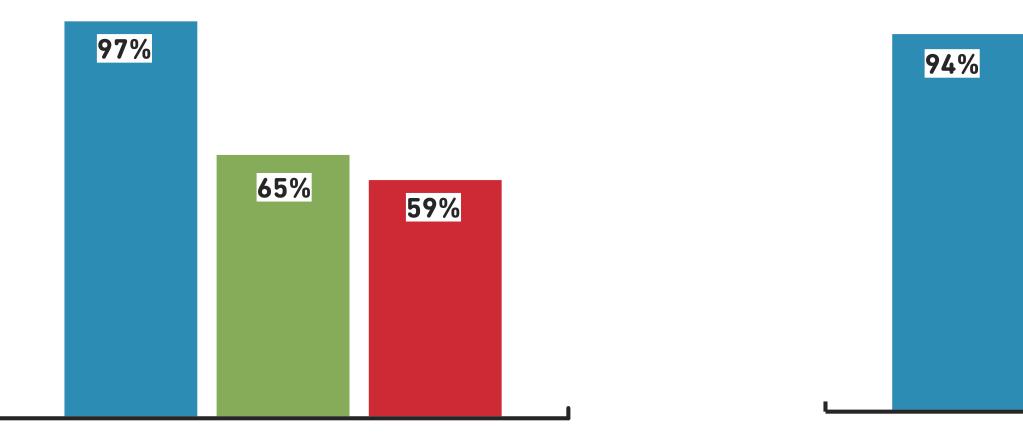
Coverage rates of full concessions (%)

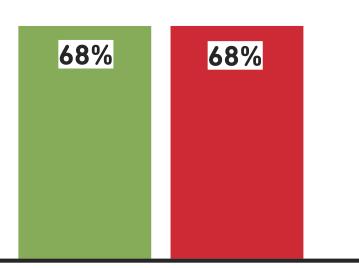

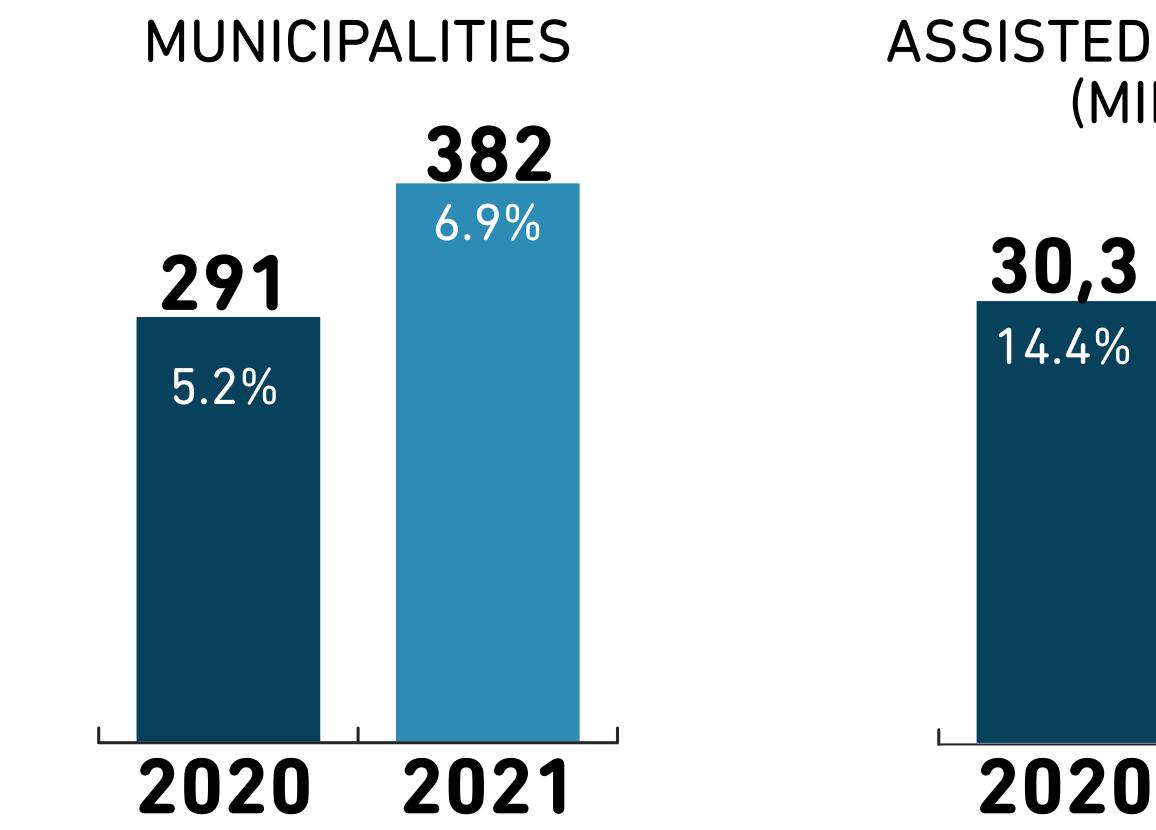

Considering only the ongoing bids, the private sector will operate in almost 7% of the municipalities and 16.7% of the Brazilian population.
